

Election announcement

for the election of the 16th student parliament, the Autonomes Ausländer*innen Referat and the Queer-feministisches Referat

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Electoral committee

The student parliament of the constituted student body of TU Dortmund elected the following students as members of the electoral committee in its meeting on 10.03.2022:

Leon Arlt, Isabella Emken, Anton Eplinius, Leander Schreyer and Cara-Milena Zaremba.

At the same meeting, the student parliament elected Florian Lippert and Simon Neuhaus as deputy members.

The electoral committee was constituted on 23.03.2022 by the student parliament's presidium. In that meeting Cara-Milena Zaremba was elected as election supervisor and Leander Schreyer was elected as deputy election supervisor.

The electoral committee for the election of the student parliament is also responsible for the elections of the Autonomes Ausländer*innen Referat and the Queer-feministisches Referat according to these departments' statutes.

Period and type of the election

As per the student parliament's decision made on 10.03.2022, the elections will take place from 23.05.2022 to 02.06.2022.

In accordance with the statutes of the Autonomes Ausländer*innen Referat and the Queer-feministisches Referat, the elections for these departments will take place in connection with the elections for the student parliament.

Per the student parliament's decision made on 07.10.2019, the elections will be held online.

Access to the election system

An election notification with the means of access to the election system will be sent separately.

For those who are eligible to vote and are not able to cast their vote electronically, there will be a possibility to vote online in the rooms of the AStA, Emil-Figge-Straße 50, on weekdays from 09:30am to 03:00pm.

Bodies to be elected and eligibility to vote

Student parliament

The student parliament of the constituted student body of TU Dortmund is being elected. The student parliament consists of a maximum of 35 members.

Students who are enrolled as regular students at TU Dortmund on 15.04.2022 are eligible to vote and be elected, visiting students are not.

Elections are made according to electoral lists, and their establishment is free. The internal structure of the electoral list must follow democratic principles.

Every student has one vote.

Of the total number of seats to be allocated, each electoral list is allocated as many seats as they are entitled to according to the ratio of the votes they received as per the Sainte-Laguë method.

The seats on each electoral list determined using the above procedure are assigned according to the number of votes for the individual candidates within the electoral list. In the event of a tie between several candidates on an electoral list, or if no vote is cast for several candidates, the order of the candidates on the electoral list decides the ranking. In the event of a tie between multiple electoral lists, the election supervisor decides which electoral list will receive the seat by drawing lots.

Queer-feministisches Referat

The Queer-feministisches Referat of the constituted student body of TU Dortmund is being elected. The Queer-feministisches Referat consists of a maximum of 5 representatives.

Female students who are enrolled as regular students at TU Dortmund on 15.04.2022 are eligible to vote and be elected, visiting students are not.

In this election, voters will elect individual representatives, not electoral lists. Every student who is eligible to vote has one vote.

The five candidates who received the most votes are the new representatives. In the event of a tie, the election supervisor will draw lots.

Autonomes Ausländer*innen Referat

The Autonomes Ausländer*innen Referat of the constituted student body of TU Dortmund is being elected. The Autonomes Ausländer*innen Referat consists of a maximum of 5 representatives.

Foreign students who are enrolled as foreign regular students at TU Dortmund on 15.04.2022 are eligible to vote and be elected. Students who were representatives for the Autonomes Ausländerinnen Referat three times before cannot be elected again. Visiting students are not eligible to vote.

In this election, voters will elect individual representatives, not electoral lists. Students who are eligible to vote have five votes that can be used to vote for up to five candidates. They cannot vote for one candidate more than once.

The five candidates who received the most votes are the new representatives. They have to have different nationalities ("Five-Countries-Rule"). If there is no woman or no man in the group of elected students, the woman or man who got the highest amount of votes will become the fifth member, taking the "Five-Countries-Rule" into account.

In the event of a tie, the election supervisor will draw lots.

Nominations

Nominations have to be submitted with the electoral committee by 25.04.2022, 3pm digitally and in written form at AStA. There will be one date for handing nominations in person at the general students committee: 25.04. from 10am to 3pm. The authorization of the nominations will be announced on the committee's websites (see also: documents online).

Student parliament

Every student who is eligible to vote and be elected can nominate themselves or others.

Along with every nomination, a written irrevocable declaration by the candidate has to be submitted, in which they state their consent to the nomination.

Each candidate can only be included in one nomination.

The nomination must contain at least the first and last names, addresses, the student e-mail address, and matriculation number of the candidates and state the election that it applies to. The name of the electoral list also has to be included and cannot be longer than 70 characters.

In every nomination, a confidant and a replacement have to be named.

Additionally, the name of the list, as well as the first and last names of all the candidates have to be sent to the electoral committee's e-mail address as a digital file.

Queer-feministisches Referat

Every student who is eligible to vote and be elected can nominate themselves or others.

Along with every nomination, a written irrevocable declaration by the candidate has to be submitted, in which they state their consent to the nomination.

The nomination must contain at least the first and last names, addresses, the student e-mail address, and matriculation number of the candidates and state the election that it applies to.

Autonomes Ausländer*innen Referat

Every student who is eligible to vote and be elected can nominate themselves or others.

Along with every nomination, a written irrevocable declaration by the candidate has to be submitted, in which they state their consent to the nomination.

The nomination must contain at least the first and last names, addresses, the student e-mail address, and matriculation number of the candidates and state the election that it applies to.

Election brochure

The electoral committee will hand out an election brochure online and printed. Submissions will be accepted until the end of 05.05.2022. In all contributions, a person who is responsible for the contents according to the state press law has to be named.

Contributions can be sent to the electoral committee's address via e-mail. If mails cannot be sent due to the size of the attachments, e.g. Sciebo can be used to generate a link to the attachment, which can then be sent to the committee. These links have to be accessible until one week after the submission deadline.

The contributions by electoral lists and candidates should be formatted as follows:

Electoral lists for student parliament: One PDF file with two pages in DIN-A4. These will be printed next to each other. The election brochure will be printed in portrait format.

Individuals for the Autonome Referate: A PDF file in DIN-A5. On one page of the election brochure up to two candidates will be presented.

Electoral register

Two electoral registers will be created (one for the student parliament and Queer-feministisches Referat, one for the Autonomes Ausländer*innen Referat).

Both will be displayed in the AStA premises during opening hours from 22.04.2022 to 30.04.2022. They can be inspected after making an appointment with the AStA (Tel. 0231-755 2584) and while adhering to the current hygiene measures.

During that time, objections against the accuracy of the electoral register can be declared with the election supervisor in writing. The electoral committee will generally decide about the objection immediately but at the latest until 22 days before the first day of elections.

Students who are not registered are not eligible to vote.

Postal vote

According to the electoral regulations there will be no postal vote due to the online-elections.

Draw of the order of lists and candidates

The order of lists and individual candidates will be drawn publicly by the electoral committee on 25.04.2022 at 5 p.m. in Emil-Figge-Straße 50.

Further information will be announced with the invite to the meeting.

Vote count

Immediately after the election is completed the first count which will be public within the university is carried out. Further information will be announced with the election notification.

Announcement of the results

The results will be announced at the latest on the 07.06.2022 in the AStA premises, in the building Emil-Figge-Straße 50, as well as the student parliament's homepage (<https://stupa-dortmund.de/> and associated websites).

Examination of the election

Every student can object to the validity of the election within 14 days after the announcement of the results. The objection and specification of reasons have to be submitted in writing with the election supervisor. The newly elected student parliament will decide about the objections.

Meeting with the new student parliament and the Autonome Referate

The election supervisor will invite the new student parliament and the Autonome Referate to the constituting meetings. Time and place will be publicly announced with the election results
